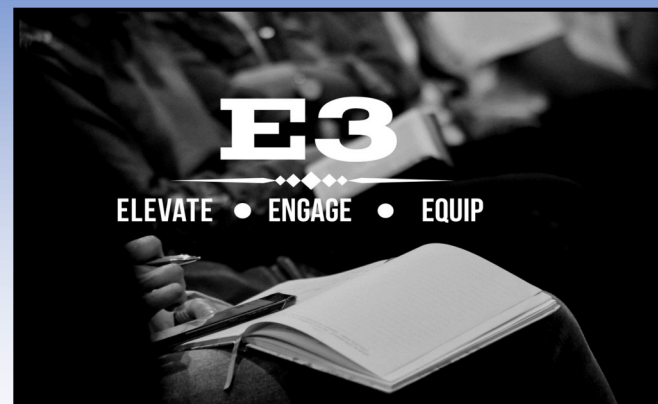

Griffey Baby Shower

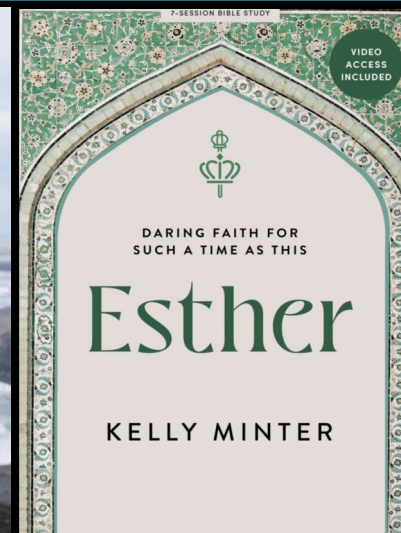
The Christian Women's Fellowship of HCC

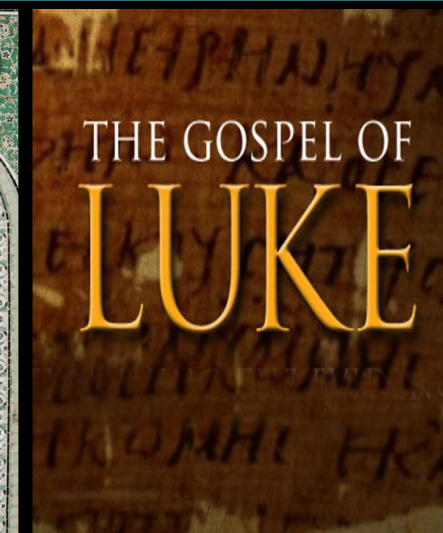
