The Bible is full of names of people, places, and things over the course of thousands of years. Some of them are familiar like Moses, David, Abraham, Peter, and Paul. Some are not as familiar. People like Parosh and Zattu. Some of them are hard to pronounce and some of them are funny to say. Some are both. Try saying the name Mephibosheth without a smile. Couldn't do it, could you? It sounds

like a big sneeze. Just writing it makes me laugh!

But with each of those names comes a story. They were real people like you and me with a life of decisions and events, good and bad, with generations of stories that led up to that point in history when their name was written down in the Bible for people to read for millennia after. Sometimes, the story is one of courage, honor, and faith. Sometimes, the name is remembered for faithlessness and sin. Their names and lives serve as lessons in our Sunday School classes, Bible studies, and sermons for Christians throughout the centuries.

I've often wondered, if my story was in the Bible, what would it say? How would I be remembered? Would teachers and preachers look past me in a long list of genealogy or would I be used as an illustration in lessons and sermons on God's goodness, faithfulness, mercy, and grace. I hope the latter. How will your story, your name, your legacy be remembered? If you're breathing, the story isn't over yet. We still have an opportunity to leave a legacy for Jesus.
