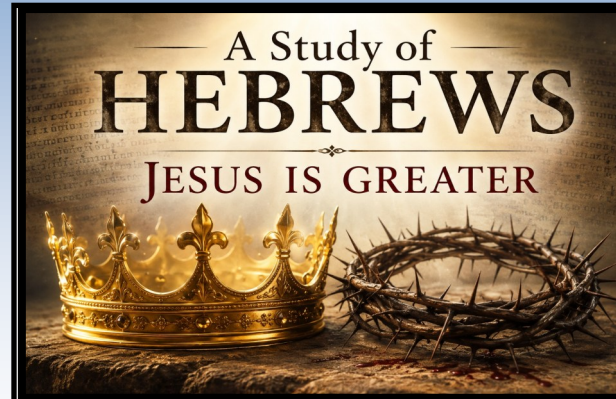

Week of September 21, 2026



“You don’t understand!” How many times have you heard that or maybe even said it? Most teenagers gently share that with their parents as they try to comfort them in a moment of hurt or despair. (Note the tone of sarcasm in that sentence. I’m not sure if many teenagers ever speak in a gentle tone to their parents unless it’s asking for the car keys or money. Or, maybe that was

just me. It probably was.) Little did I realize that my parents did understand, at least to some degree, because they’d been there and done that long before me.

I’ve learned over the years that one of the statements to avoid when you’re trying to comfort someone is to say “I understand” or “I know how you feel”. The truth is that we probably don’t. Even though I may have experienced something similar, I can’t honestly say that I feel what someone else feels. In those moments, the best thing I can do is just be present and listen.

We can think the same thing about God as He gives us instruction and comfort. “That’s easy for You to say, God. You’ve never experienced what I’m experiencing. You’ve never felt what I’m feeling. You don’t understand.”

Oh, but He does. That’s one of the amazing things about the incarnation of Jesus. Not only did Jesus come to earth to reveal God to us and to die on the cross for our sins. He also came to experience everything we’ve experienced. Jesus really can say “I understand” and “I know how you feel”. Jesus is greater!

We’re going to talk about that this week and what it means for us. I encourage you to read Hebrews 2:5-18 this week and meditate on what it means for us to have a Savior who experienced life on this earth. We look forward to worshipping with you on Sunday and bring a friend. Have a great week!

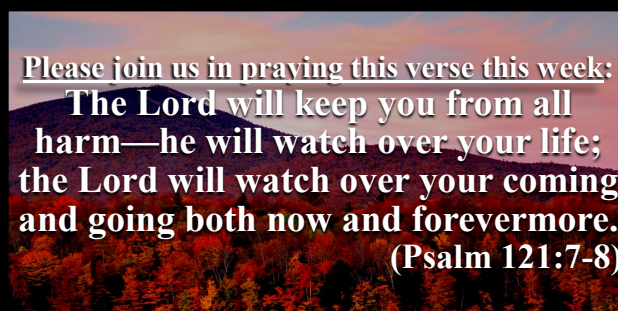
HCC Men's Fellowship Dinner

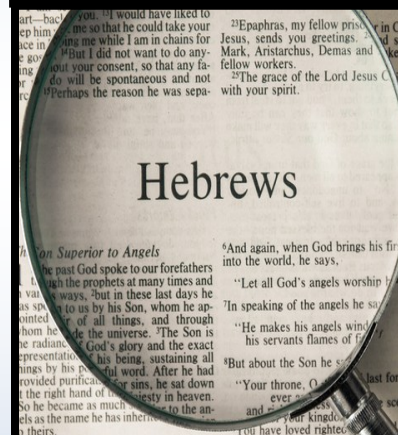

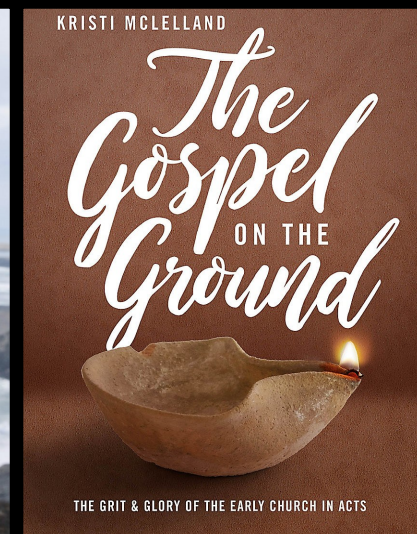
