Last words are important and often tell us something about the person who spoke them. They are treasured by loved ones and sometimes recorded in history for all to know. As I was preparing for our next sermon, I ran across a list of famous last words as listed by Pastor Greg Laurie. Let me

share some of them with you.

Some last words aren't very memorable. At his death, Karl Marx scolded his housekeeper for wanting final words from the communist revolutionary. His final utterance was: "Go on, get out! Last words are for fools who haven't said enough!" And comedian Groucho Marx said, "Die, my dear? Why that's the last thing I'll do." He was right about that. And prognosticator Nostradamus? "You will not find me alive at sunrise." Great prediction. He was right, too. And, finally, Pancho Villa, another famous revolutionary said, "Don't let it end like this. Tell them I said something." Not the greatest quote to be remembered by.
