Freedom through submission Read Mark 10:1-12

- The question – Mark 10:2
- Jesus’ response – Mark 10:3 Look at what is in scripture
- Their response – Deuteronomy 24:1
- The heart of the matter – Mark 10:5-9
- Grace and truth – John 1:17

The Pharisees were worried about what was legally allowed while Jesus focused God’s design for marriage.

The Bible includes passages on marriage, divorce, re-marriage, and remaining unmarried. – Matthew 19, Mark 10, Luke 16, 1 Corinthians 7, Exodus 21.

God is not calling us to stay in a place of abuse or adultery.

Divorce for any reason hurts and that was not what God intended.

God’s design for marriage is a lifetime covenant between one man and one woman who love God most and each other second only to GOD.

There’s nothing wrong or less spiritual about remaining unmarried.

We enjoy the freedom to be who we were created to be when we submit to God’s authority.

- Romans 6:22

God will heal our broken relationships and it begins with submission to the King of Kings and Lord of Lords as Savior and Lord.

Access through faith (Part 1)

- Receive the Kingdom like a child. See Jesus with childlike faith. You don’t have to understand it all at once– Read **Mark 10:13-15**

Access through faith (Part 2) Read Mark 10:17-31

- The question – Mark 10:17 What must I do? Works not faith
- Jesus’ response – Mark 10:21

Jesus has a way of revealing our heart with His words.

Money can become a barrier to entering the Kingdom because we can think it provides all that we need therefore we don’t realize we need Jesus.

Mark 10:28AMPC Peter started to say to Him, Behold, we have yielded up and abandoned everything [once and for all and joined You as Your disciples, siding with Your party] and accompanied You [walking the same road that You walk].

Read Mark 10:32-34 Jesus predicts His death a 3rd time in Mark

Read Mark 10:35-45 What was James and John’s request? vs 36

“What do you want me to do for you?”

Read Eph: 1:18-23>**Where is Jesus now and what is under His feet?**

Read Eph 2:6-10 Where are we as Christians now?

Read Phil 2:8-11 How can we be like Jesus here?

Read Mark 10:46-52 What was Blind Bartimaeus’s request in vs 51?

Are you willing to ask Jesus to let you see Him and then follow Him?

Action Steps

- Be honest with yourself: Is there an area in your life that you have not submitted to God’s authority? Let it go!
- Are you willing to ask Jesus to reveal Himself to you so you can see and surrender to Him?
