Have you ever had a guilty conscience? Come on. Admit it. You have. Some people feel like they have to tell someone even if no one could ever find out what they did. It's just in them. Even if they think they might have done something wrong when they really hadn't, they'll still tell on themselves. Then, there's the folks who'll never admit to anything. I dealt with a lot of those folks when I was a

high school principal. Back then, we had to talk to lots of people and gather information from anyone who might have seen what happened. Now, It's recorded on camera and posted online for the whole world to see. They may have even posted it themselves. Doesn't matter. "Nope. That's not me. Don't know what you're talking about. Must be someone else."

The problem with never confessing or admitting to a wrong we've committed is that we never experience the relief and release of forgiveness. Unconfessed guilt can be a heavy, heavy load to carry and it can weigh on us and break us down physically, emotionally, and spiritually. Confession truly is good for the soul. And the body and the mind.

In Nehemiah's day, Israel was faced with how to respond to God's conviction for their sins. Should they ignore and stuff those feelings of guilt and remorse or should they confess and experience the forgiveness and restoration of God?

We'll talk about that this Sunday as we look at Nehemiah 9. I hope you'll read ahead and pray over God's Word. This is a powerful passage on confession of sin following the conviction of the Holy Spirit. I encourage you to prepare yourself for worship as we come together to lift up the Only Righteous One. Have a great week and bring a friend to church. There's always room for one more. See you on Sunday!
