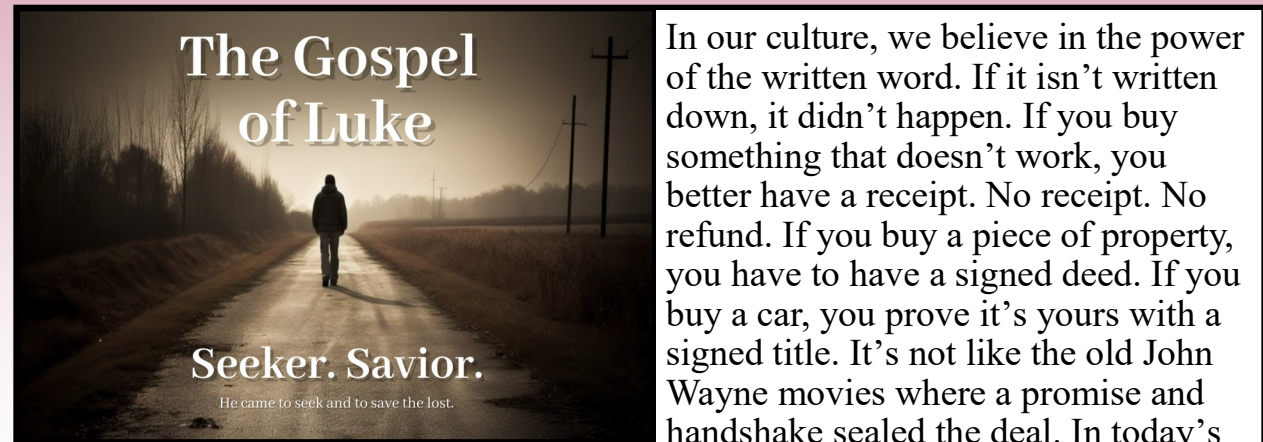

In our culture, we believe in the power of the written word. If it isn't written down, it didn't happen. If you buy something that doesn't work, you better have a receipt. No receipt. No refund. If you buy a piece of property, you have to have a signed deed. If you buy a car, you prove it's yours with a signed title. It's not like the old John Wayne movies where a promise and handshake sealed the deal. In today's

business environment, we create and sign contracts between two people or two companies when we come to an agreement. If it's written down, it's in stone (kinda). And the deal isn't final until it's signed. One provision you usually find in most contracts is a way to opt-out or break the contract. If one party does something outside of the contract, the deal is null and void and the agreement is off. It's interesting and maybe a little sad that we enter into contracts with the understanding that we can break it and the core reason for all of that is probably a lack of trust. "I don't trust that you'll follow through on what you agreed to. I can't take you at your word. So, we have to have a signed contract that will allow me to break it or will give me a loophole so I can break it." I guess no contract really is final and that creates more mistrust.

I'm so glad that God didn't enter into a contract with me. I don't know about you but I don't want Him to have a loophole that will allow Him to pull out of our relationship because I messed up again. I'd be in big trouble. We don't have a contract with God. We have a covenant and that's very different.

We're going to talk about that this week as we discuss Luke 22:1-23. I hope you'll read ahead as we prepare to gather together to worship, pray and to study God's Word. Have a great week! And, bring a friend.

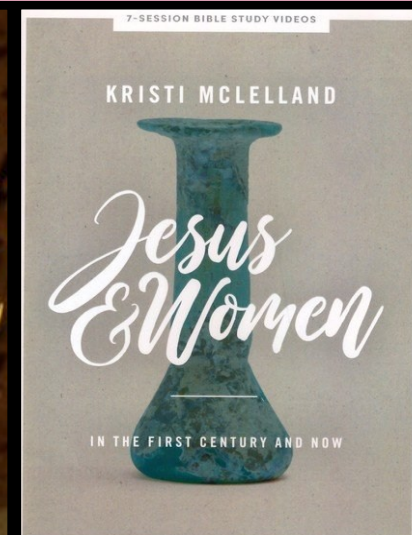
