Week of July 6, 2026



I sometimes hear people say that our politics today is the worst it's ever been and the nation is more divided than it's ever been. As a former history teacher, I'm not sure that's accurate. I still love history and watch history documentaries and read historical biographies, especially of American presidents. I just finished a biography of Lincoln and have started one on U.S. Grant. Very interesting reading.

One of the things that's struck me as I've learned more about the past is that politics in America has always been pretty rough. From the very beginning, political parties controlled and used the media to spread their propaganda, much of it untrue. They even had specific newspapers that were dedicated to a party or a candidate and the reporting was skewed that way. There were constant threats and accusations being spread. Sounds a lot like today, doesn't it?

But, that doesn't make it right. One of the most common tactics in politics is to discredit the candidate or the official if you can't undermine their position or policy. Make the person look bad or dig up some dirt to make the public dislike them and, hopefully, vote against them. They did that in the past, too.

But, again, that isn't anything new. It's been going on for thousands of years. Even though he wasn't running for office, Nehemiah had to deal with some of the same pressures and tactics. Threats against his life. Attempts to discredit him. All to try to get the work on the wall to stop.

We'll talk about that this Sunday and look at how Nehemiah responded. There's a lot we can learn from that. I encourage you to read ahead in Nehemiah 6 this week and prepare your heart and mind to gather together for worship as the body of Christ. Have a great week and bring a friend to church. There's always room for one more. See you on Sunday!
