

Disciple Notes

Week of March 16, 2026



As you read the last few chapters of Luke's gospel, the passage covering the last twenty-four hours or so of Jesus' life, there are a lot of different people in the story. There are the disciples who love Jesus but struggled to understand what's about to happen and continue to wrestle with some of the same sins they've faced throughout the gospel, namely pride, arrogance, and ambition. Within that group is

Judas, the traitor, and Peter, the denier. Then there's the religious leaders who've already made their minds up about Jesus' guilt before they even put Him on trial. There's Pilate, the Roman governor with all of the power but little backbone. And, Herod Antipas, the wannabe king who mocks Jesus, the King of Kings. There's also the fickle crowd that cheered a few days earlier and now calls for Jesus' death, swayed by the religious leaders. In the final hours, we see the Roman soldiers who mercilessly nailed Jesus to the cross. And, finally, there are the two thieves crucified beside Jesus. One cursing. The other repenting.

Within this cast of humanity, we see sin in all of its glory. We behold all of the ugliness and ruthlessness. And, if we look closely enough, we see ourselves somewhere in the crowd. It's so easy to think that we'd never be like "those" folks if we'd been there. In reality, we'd probably be with them every step of the way. But, the redeeming thought in it all is Jesus' prayer while hanging on the cross: "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." Regardless of what we've done, His grace is greater than all our sin.

We're going to talk about that and more this week as we discuss Luke 23:26-43. I hope you'll read ahead as we prepare to gather together to worship, pray and study God's Word. Have a great week! And, bring a friend.




