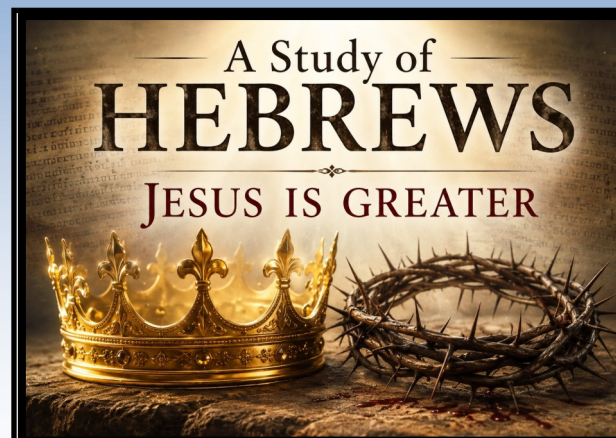

On the whole, I'm a pretty cautious guy. If someone gives me a warning, I'll listen and usually try to follow the directions. Especially, if it's a state trooper who just pulled me over for going a little too fast (I know that's hard to believe) and gave me a warning instead of the ticket I deserved. That's what you call mercy. Warnings like that are always appreciated. A big thank you to all of those officers who have been

generous to me over the years.

The world is full of warnings. They're on the side of food packages, household appliances, and cups of coffee at McDonald's. "Watch out! This coffee is really hot!" "Do not hold onto the wrong end of the chainsaw." "Remove child before folding stroller." "Wheelbarrow not intended for highway use." Those seem like pretty obvious warnings, right? But, most of the warning labels we see are the result of someone who did the very thing that you're being warned not to do. "You didn't tell me I shouldn't grab on to the blade end of the chain saw. So, it must be your fault that I now have seven fingers instead of ten."

The book of Hebrews has five warnings in it and each one is pretty serious with consequences that can be eternal. Unfortunately, there are people, including Christians, who ignore those warnings with life-changing impact.

This week, we're going to look at the first of those warnings found in chapter two. "Pay attention. Listen carefully. Don't drift away." I encourage you to read chapter two of Hebrews this week and meditate on the Greater Jesus who has given us the greater message. We look forward to worshipping with you on Sunday and bring a friend. 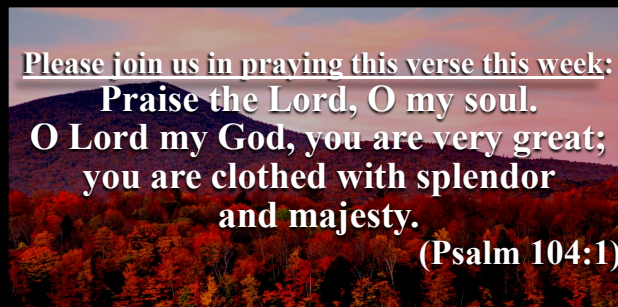

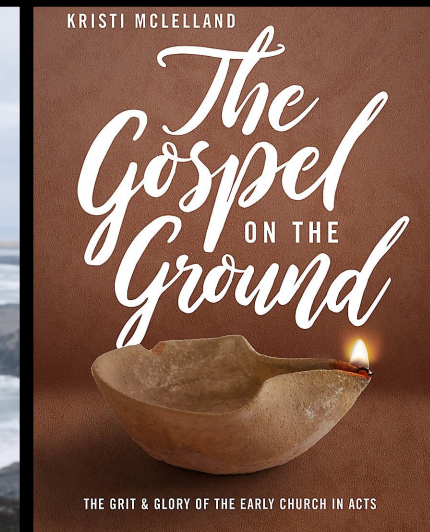

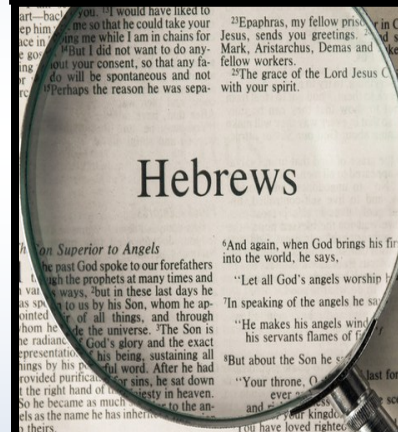
