Week of June 15, 2026



I learned long ago through a series of mistakes that you can't always go on what someone else tells you, especially if you're a leader. People sometimes color their descriptions of the truth with their opinions or biases. They may not mean to do that (sometimes they do), but it's hard to not let your own take on things influence your understanding of events. We all do that to some degree, right?

So, I learned the hard way that it's important to gather as much information as possible from different people with different perspectives in order to try to get the best take on what really happened or on what's really needed. Or, even better, to try to see the situation for myself through unfiltered eyes.

That's what Nehemiah did when he arrived in Jerusalem to rebuild the walls. He went out to take a look for himself to see just how bad the damage was and what needed to be done. And, it was bad. Really bad. But, not so bad that he quit before he started. He saw the problem and the work to be done with "eyes wide open" but he also had faith that the work could be done. Now, he just needed help to do the good work God had for them to do.

We're going to talk about that this Sunday as we look at Nehemiah 2:11-3:32. I hope you'll read ahead but don't let all of the unusual names and places throw you. Sometimes those long lists in the Bible can get a little overwhelming and discouraging. But, there's a lot to learn from this passage. A lot for us as individuals and as a church.

So, let's read about this good work that the Lord had for Nehemiah and his team and let's consider what good work God has for us. Let's prepare our hearts to worship Jesus, the Ultimate Rebuilder, as we come together this Sunday. Have a great week and bring a friend to church. There's always room for one more!
