Week of July 20, 2026



Jesus was a master teacher and story teller. He could make the most challenging theological points clear and easy to understand for those who really wanted to grasp it. That was the key. Some didn't really want to get it. They were just interested in miracles and food for their bellies. But, for those who really wanted to understand what He was talking about, He explained things about God's

Kingdom in a way that they could grasp. They had "ears to hear".

That's what teaching and preaching is about. Helping people understand and apply God's Word to their lives. It doesn't do a lot of good to talk about God using words that no one can grasp. It may make us feel better or smarter but it doesn't help the other person.

I sometimes have people, including Christians, tell me that they've read the Bible all their lives but they don't really understand it. That's when I encourage them to get in a good Bible study with someone who does know what it means and can help them understand it. In the end, it's the Holy Spirit who reveals the meaning of God's Word but we can make it harder or easier by the way we share it with others. If you ask a teacher, they'll share the joy of seeing a student's "light" come on when they understand something new. The same is true for a preacher when the Holy Spirit uses something you said to help them understand.

After the wall was finished, Nehemiah and his team turned their attention to helping others understand and apply God's Word to their lives. And, it wasn't going to be easy.

We'll talk about that this Sunday as we look at Nehemiah 8. I hope you'll read ahead and prepare yourself for worship. Have a great week and bring a friend to church. There's always room for one more. See you on Sunday!
