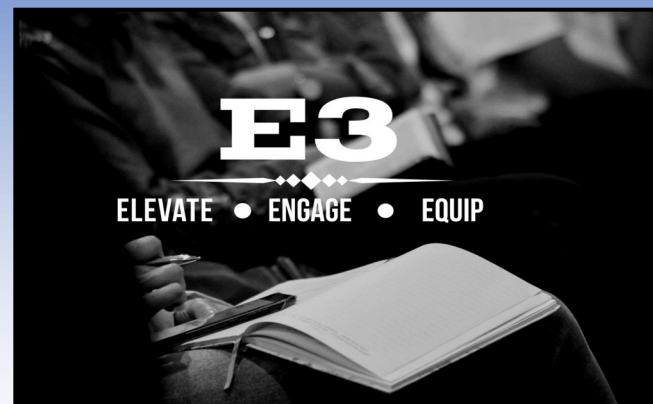

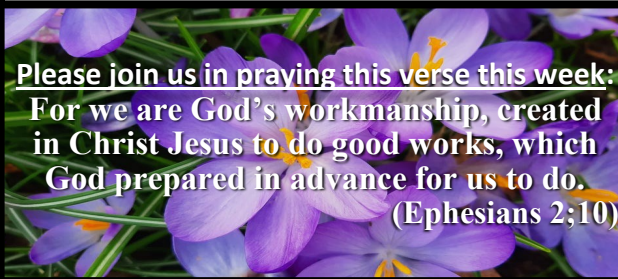

exciting time of worship.

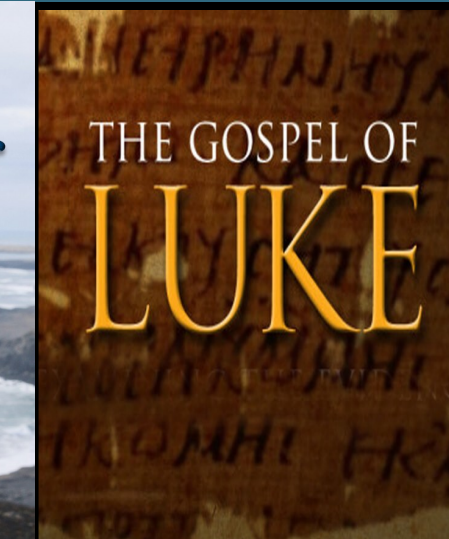
