Week of May 18, 2026



Holly and I love to sit on our back deck and share a meal or read a book. The view is gorgeous and it's one of the most relaxing places I know. The deck is surrounded by tall trees, full of green leaves in the spring and summer and bright, vibrant colors in the fall. And, in the distance, you can see two tall mountain peaks rising above the valley. We can even take a nap on a couple of reclining chairs when the

weather cooperates. That deck has been a blessing to our family.

Sitting on the deck a few days ago, I watched the trees and the leaves sway in the gentle wind and it made me think of Jesus' conversation with Nicodemus. As they talked, Jesus said, "The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it's going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit." (John 3:8) As the leaves were moving that afternoon, I couldn't see the actual wind blowing. But, I could see the result. I could see the motion it caused, hear the rustling leaves, and feel the breeze against my face. Some people question the Holy Spirit or even God Himself because they can't see Him. But, oh, we can see Him at work and we can experience Him every day. We can see lives changed, prayers answered, souls saved. 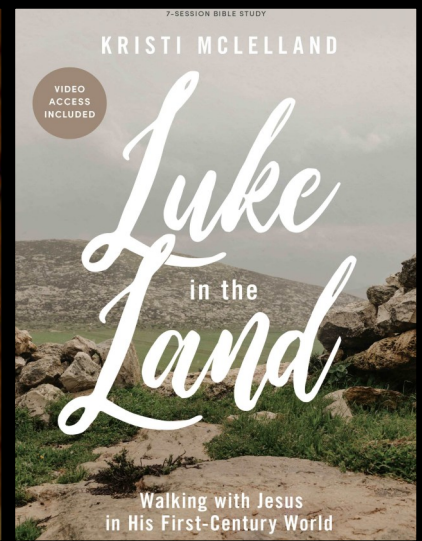

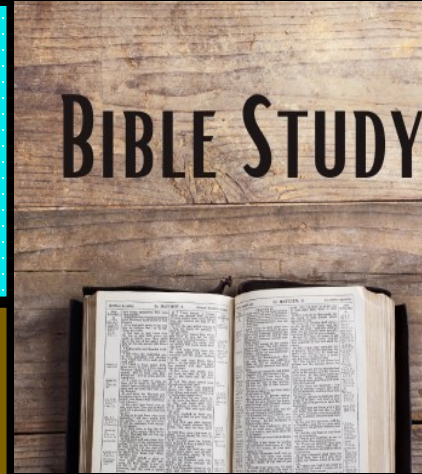
