 - Mark 10:14 – the "such as these"

Application

- What angers GOD should anger us, unless we have tolerated it too long. How do we get numb to God's Word in our lives?

- We are **the temple** of God.
 - 1 Corinthians 3:16-18.1 Cor.6:12-20
 - Psalm 36:1-2 **What happens to the wicked person's heart?**
- Our sin defiles God's temple.
 - Romans 12:9

God sees our sin as destructive to us, a barrier in our relationship with Him, and a hindrance to His purpose and glory.

Coming into God's presence in worship helps us recognize our need for **repentance**. Our Savior and Lord Jesus can teach us how to repent and use us in our new life in Him.
