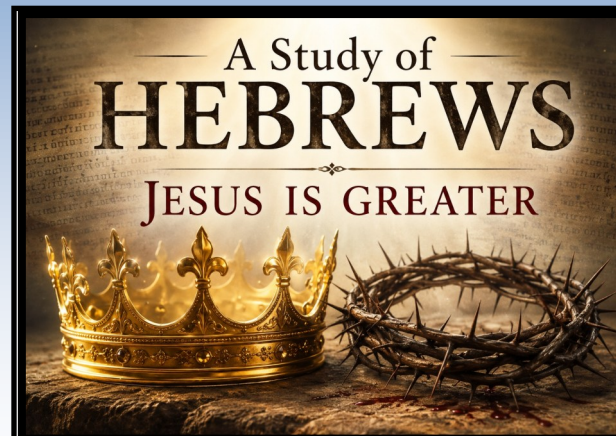

People have long been fascinated with the spiritual world and spiritual beings. Ancient art work is full of symbols and representations of what people thought about the spirit world. Some people don't believe in any of that but the Bible is full of examples of beings that we can't see or hear but are very active around us. Scripture speaks of evil spiritual beings like Satan and his demons who carry out his bidding to

work against anything or anyone who serves God and His purpose. And, there are good spiritual beings like cherubim, seraphim, and the "living creatures" of heaven who continually worship God. The most famous of all are the angels, created by God to be His servants and messengers. The best known angels are probably Michael, the angel in charge of God's armies, and God's special messenger, Gabriel.

Artists have sometimes portrayed angels as little babies with tiny wings and harps or adults with great big wings and gentle, loving faces. The truth is that angels are powerful, mighty creatures who often cause people to fall at their feet in awe and fear. Angels are not to be messed with. Their purpose is to do what God instructs them to do and they don't let anyone or anything get in their way.

But, as awesome as they are, there is Someone who is greater and more powerful. Someone who is God's Message instead of a messenger. Of course, that Someone is Jesus.

Last week, we talked about Jesus, greater than the prophets. This Sunday, we'll focus on Jesus, greater than the angels. 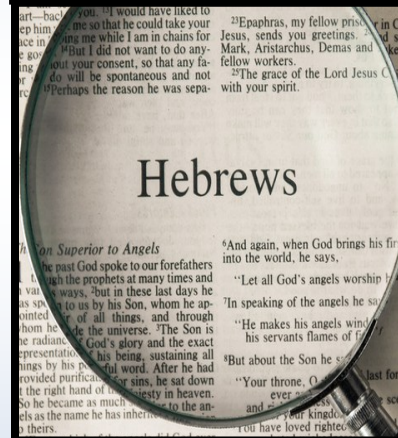
Women's GriefShare

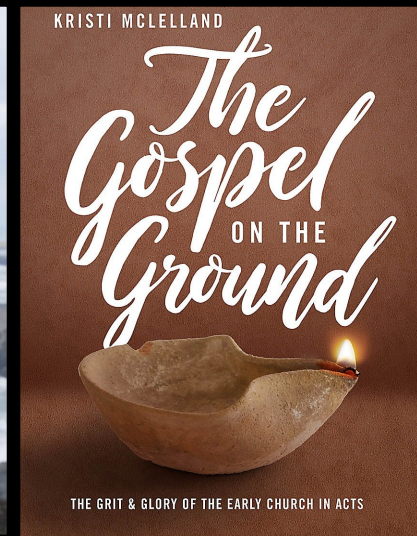
