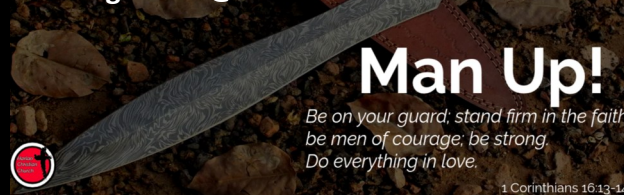
HCC Rafting Trip
