

# Disciple Notes

*Week of March 23, 2026*



As we've been working our way through the last few chapters of Luke's gospel, the passage covering the last twenty-four hours or so of Jesus' life, I've noticed this little three word phrase that's popped up a couple of times—"at a distance". When Jesus was arrested and taken to the home of the high priest, Peter followed at a distance. When Jesus was being crucified, some of the women who

followed Him from Galilee looked on from a distance. For some, like Peter, the distance was probably out of fear of being associated with Jesus. For others, like the women, distance may have helped them better deal with the grief of what was taking place on that cross.

Either way, those who were ridiculing, abusing, and mocking Jesus were close to Him and those who loved Him most were most distant. In those moments when He needed a tender word of encouragement or a familiar face of strength and love, many were at a distance. And, most significantly, for the first time in eternity, His Heavenly Father was also distant, separated from His Son by our sin laid on the Lord. How hard that must have been for Jesus in His humanity. In the midst of a crowd gathered to watch Him die, Jesus was alone. Jesus knows what it's like to feel abandoned, alone in life's most difficult moments.

We're going to talk about that and more this week as we discuss Luke 23:44-56. I hope you'll read ahead as we prepare to gather together to worship, pray and study God's Word. And don't forget that our children will sing at the beginning of this week's Palm Sunday service. Parents should have their children in the sanctuary by 10:15 on Sunday morning if they want to participate. Have a great week! And, bring a friend.






