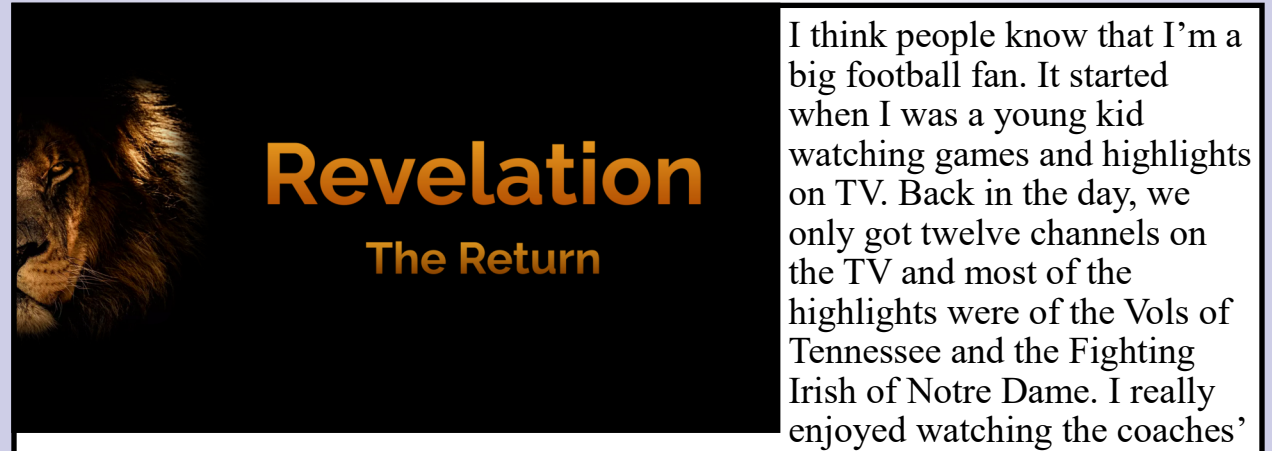

I picked up on some of the traditions of the schools as I watched the shows and I remember hearing about four Notre Dame players from the 1920s, the celebrated backfield known as the “four horsemen”. (And, no, I’m not old enough to have actually seen them play.) These guys were unstoppable, losing only two games during the three seasons they played together.

This week, we’ll return to the book of Revelation, picking up where we left off with chapter six. As we do, we’ll read about the most feared four horsemen in history, riding across the earth as Jesus opens the seals of the scroll. Unlike the Notre Dame players, there will be no cheering when these horsemen arrive bringing death and destruction with them. This is the beginning of the Tribulation, the seven years of unmatched suffering and misery as God pours out His judgment and wrath upon the sinful world.

I encourage you to take the time to read chapter six this week in preparation for our time together. And let me encourage you again to join us in worship in person, if possible. There’s no substitute for worshiping with God’s people in the same room. Have a great week and bring a friend!
